

COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

The Stein Fjell Community Scholarship is open to senior high school students residing in the communities served by Stein Fjell Lodge who intend to continue their education at an accredited post-high-school educational institution. This one-time scholarship will be in an amount of \$1,000 and will be sent to the recipient. If there is only one application received between the Community and Member-Nominated Scholarship Applications, that person will be awarded \$1,500.

The criteria for selecting a scholarship recipient are as follows:

- The student has or will apply to an accredited post-high-school educational institution.
- The student has at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- The student lives in the area served by Stein Fjell Lodge (including Loveland, Fort Collins, Greeley, Longmont, Windsor, and the surrounding communities).

In addition to the above criteria, the Scholarship Committee will weight the student applicants as follows:

- Thirty percent (30%) based on the student applicant's demonstrated service to the community. This can be in various forms, such as: Letters of Acknowledgment from a community or not-for-profit organization, membership in a community or not-for-profit organization, volunteer work in school-sponsored extra-curricular activities, or similar type of community-based services.
- Thirty percent (30%) based on the student applicant's scholastic accomplishment, as measured by his or her accumulated GPA.
 - Twenty percent (20%) based on financial need.
- Twenty percent (20%) based on a typed essay, not to exceed 1,000 words, in response to the question, "How has your heritage shaped your life goals?"

The application must be received by April 1st. The recipient will be notified no later than April 22nd.
